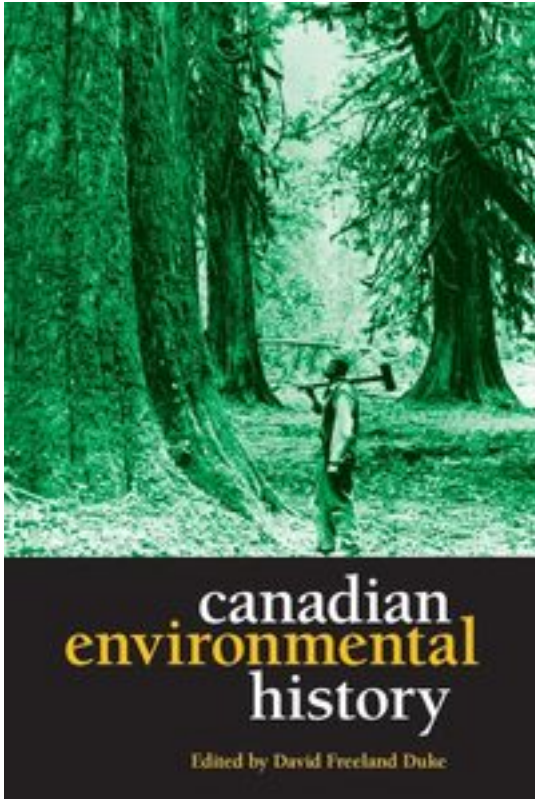


Canadian Environmental History
