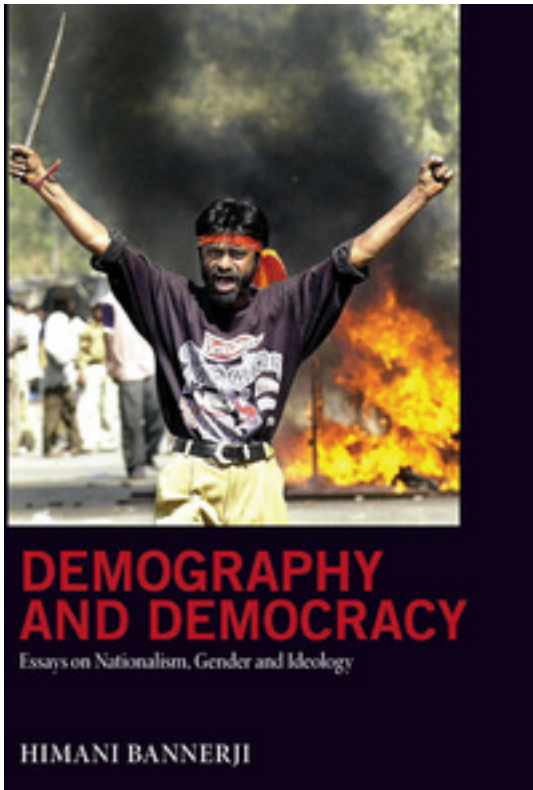


# Demography and Democracy
