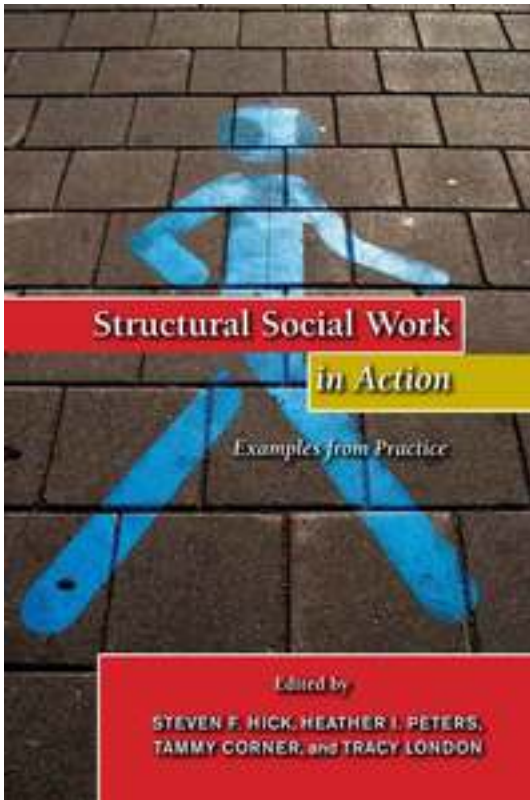


# Structural Social Work in Action
